Boulders & Glass

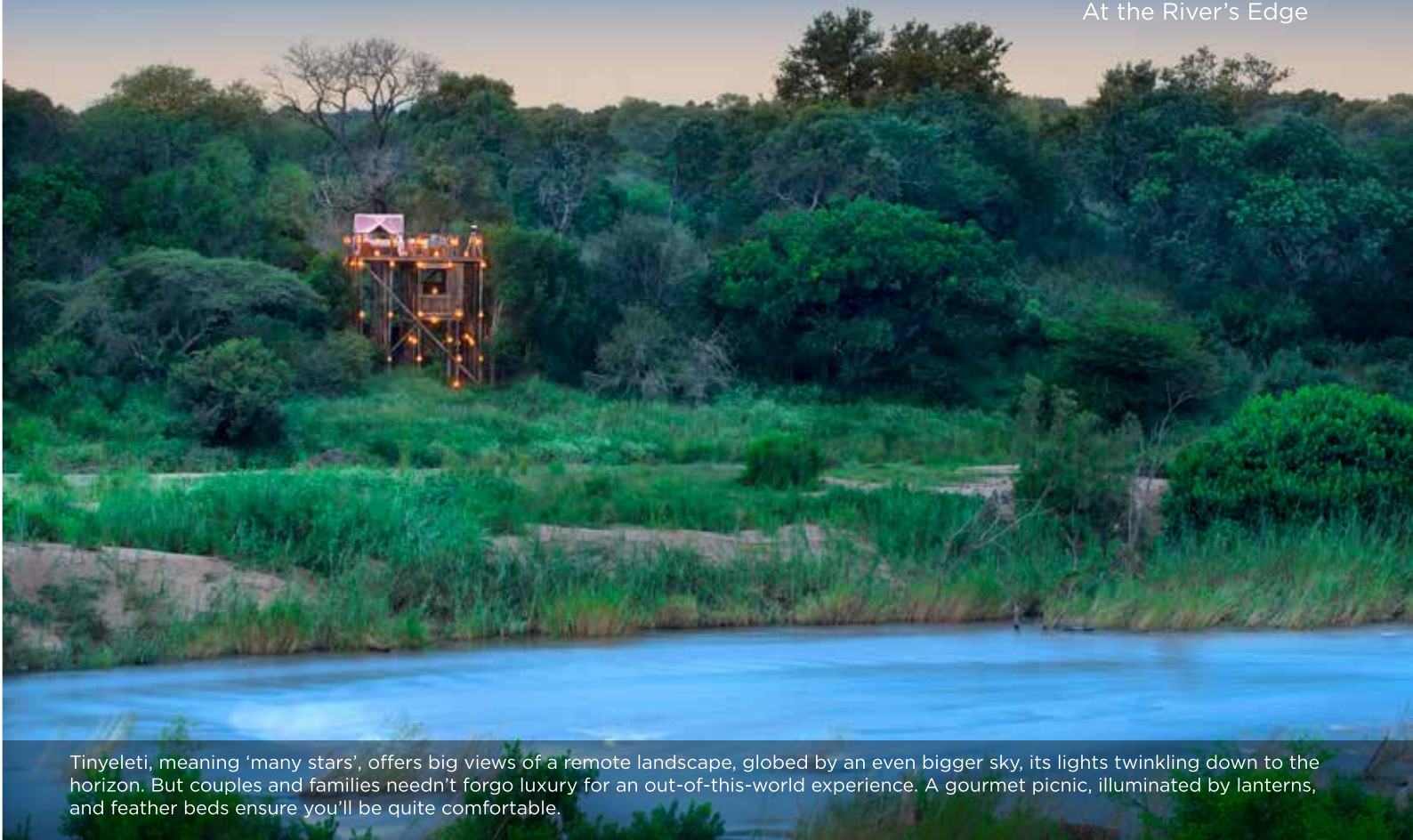
